Introduction

A successful and safe warehouse operation is one that is efficient and orderly. The warehouse employee is essential in making sure that merchandise are circulated during the facility in an efficient and timely manner. Due to the various activities involved within warehouse operations, staff in warehouse settings might be at greater risk for accidents than those who work in areas with more limited activities. Therefore, companies prioritize warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse dangers is key to avoiding accidents. Always be alert to possible dangers and methods to reduce risks. Do whatever is needed to avoid accidents.

General Hazards

Common kinds of hazard in a warehouse environment are trips, falls and slips. These accidents are normally caused when employees lose their balance or stumble over an item which has not been put away correctly. Placing or removing stuff from storage could result in a fumble or slip, potentially leading to both employee and item to fall. The potential for slips, trips and falls is increased when workers are moving supplies on various types of floor surfaces and on various levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling stuff. This is usually caused by failure to correctly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting techniques are one more common danger.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace machines. Accidents can often be caused from the improper utilization of forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks. Warehouse tools, like skids, pallets, strapping and cutting tools, should be utilized cautiously in packing, unpacking and loading.

Hazardous substances, combustible or flammable materials can pose hazards while being stored in a warehouse. Employees have to know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers when working around dangerous materials.
