MSDS or Material Safety Data Sheet training is also included in the course. Though not directly related to the use of a lift truck, MSDS training is important in case an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the proper ways of handling spills, the products and their effects on people.
