Calgary Telehandler Certification - Telehandler certification courses are both for operators who have some experience driving a typical forklift and for those with no experience. The real-world training provided by these courses produces graduates well versed in the proper and safe utilization of these kinds of machinery.

Telehandler certification programs can be completed at a third party location or at the trainees work site. To be able to get the formal training at a particular training facility, the manufacturer may work out a licensing agreement to bring other individuals to a training facility. This alternative provides trainees with the opportunity to learn to make use of the machines in a controlled setting. When completed, participants receive a certification or license to utilize this type of machinery.

When the training is carried out on the worksite, a qualified instructor is sent to the work location. This is the best way to ensure that your workers receive particular training on the equipment that they would be using, helping to train the trainee in their own work setting. Trainees learn about potentially dangerous situations that could happen on the actual work site. The instruction focuses on any circumstances that are specific to the work place, enabling operators to be prepared to handle these elements more safely.

"Telehandler" is an abbreviated version of the term "telescopic handler," that references the machines extending or telescoping arm supporting a fork. The characteristics and controls of the telehandler are somewhat like a forklift. A telehandler has the capability of lifting and transporting loads up and away from the vehicle. Improper operation of telehandlers can lead to serious accidents. If load limits are exceeded, the machine could tip because of excess weight on the lift. It is an operator's duty to know load limitations and to make use of these machinery safely.

Telehandler programs designed for operators who are already certified to use a forklift are referred to as "conversion" classes. These classes teach the differences between forklifts and telehandlers, and avoid repeating information which forklift operators already know. For trainees who have no former experience using telehandler equipment, training consists of the basic operation and use of the machine. Some organizations even provide refresher programs.
